# The danger of trying to please God

It's important to pause before we begin a study like this. We must stop and think about the motive behind this study and the motive behind all that we do in this life. If we don't stop and think about this we can quickly slide into thinking that we must try and please God for Him to love us, to save us, to make us worthy in some way. That would be a horrible place to be and a very dangerous place to be.

Let's look at Scripture to see the truth of who we are:

- Isaiah 64:6-9
- Romans 3:9-18
- Romans 3:21-26

- Isaiah 43:3b
- Psalms 51:5

So Scripture clearly paints the picture that we are utterly sinful, utterly depraved. There is no good in us apart from the grace God gives us. So there is no way for us to "earn" anything from God or bring anything to this equation. Has not His hands made all these things? (Acts 7:49,50)

Let it be clear then from the beginning that we are not trying to earn or work our way to love or salvation!

#### How are we saved?

Then the question must be answered, how are we saved? How are we loved and made right? The answer: Jesus Christ.

Again, let's turn to Scripture:

#### Do our actions matter?

If that is so, then why do our actions matter? Why do we try and make it our goal to please Him? Go back and look at 2 Corinthians 5:14. It's because of Christ's love. It's His love that compels us. Relook at the verse on the cover 2 Corinthians 5:9, but read on to verse 10. We will appear before the judgment seat of Christ. I know when I am there before Him, I want my life to have pleased Him, not out of fear of condemnation, because that is gone, but instead because I love Him and I want to please those I love and that love me.

That is why we fight hard to please Him, because of His great love for us! That love should drive us forward, and we should put that love on display for the world to see. That is why our actions matter!
