- 6. How are you guilty of making your faith an individualistic one?
 - a. What would it look like to live life in deeper community with other believers?
- 7. How have you grown in your faith from being in a deep relationship with a believer that thinks differently than you on some secondary issues?
- 8. Who do you know around you that promotes unity the most? What characterizes them and separates them from others?
